## **Current measures in France for travel**

- To leave/come to France, the Ministry of the Interior has established travel rules for 4 geographical areas. - On 9 June, 3 lists of countries have been published in several European countries: green, orange and red.
- Green list: Travellers coming from a green-listed country don't need compelling reasons to visit France and will only have to provide a negative test (PCR or antigenic) if they are not vaccinated. Vaccinated travellers don't have to be tested.
- Orange list: Vaccinated travellers have to provide a negative test. Non-vaccinated travellers can only come to France for a compelling reason with a negative test. They will have to respect a 7-day quarantine.
- Red list: It is strongly recommended but not forbidden not to travel to countries in red.
  Vaccinated persons may only travel for compelling reasons. They will be required to present a negative test and a ten-day quarantine will be imposed with control by law enforcement.
- On 30 June, the health pass will come into force at European level for travel between member states (health pass = vaccine or test).
