


Exchange app	olication information & procedure
Nomination deadline and required information	Your home university sends the following details to the incoming exchange coordinator (see above) <b>before the application deadline</b> : full name, e-mail address, field of study, and exchange period.
Prerequisites	Only students having already <b>completed their bachelors (obtained 180 ECTS)</b> , are eligible for an exchange. See <a href="here">here</a> for more info.
Application deadline fall semester	<b>30 April</b> - for an exchange during 1st semester or full academic year
Application deadline spring semester	1 October - for an exchange during the 2nd semester
Application documents	Scan of your passport or ID card; Transcript of Records with all the courses and grades of the past years at your home university; Learning Agreement containing courses and/or thesis (including the name of your KU Leuven thesis supervisor and thesis title) that you want to take in Leuven.
Course catalogue	Select courses from the <u>list</u> of our English-taught courses for exchange students. Not all courses in the English-taught masters' of our Faculty are open for Erasmus students. Note that this offer is revised before the start of every academic year, but you can already use the current list to compose an acceptable learning agreement.
	Dutch-speaking exchange students can get in touch with the Faculty exchange coordinator or academic advisor to discuss available courses in Dutch.
	Please read the <u>instructions</u> about choosing courses carefully!
Thesis	A standard thesis at KU Leuven is a full year project worth <b>24</b> or <b>30 ECTS credits</b> . Those Erasmus students who come on exchange only for one semester and already have a topic at their home university, may opt for half-year thesis project of <b>12 ECTS credits</b> .
	Regardless of the selected option, you need to <b>find a (co-)promoter in our Faculty</b> . To facilitate this, we strongly advise that the thesis promoter in your home university already has good contacts with a colleague in our Faculty. Please keep in mind that you need to have the acceptance of a professor in Leuven to be your thesis promoter <b>before the application deadline</b> . Start looking well in time!
	! Note that if you are applying at the Faculty of Engineering Science, you may not select a professor from a different faculty as your thesis supervisor.
