<b>Application deadline</b>	<p><b>Application for enrollment in September (semester 1 Sep-Jan):</b> until 30<sup>th</sup> April  <b>Application for enrollment in February (semester 2 Feb-Jun):</b> from September to 30/10  <b>Application for enrollment in September (2 semesters) :</b> until mid-march</p>
<b>Admission requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students must have completed at least 7 semesters of higher education</li> <li>- Excellent academic results especially in Math and Physics</li> <li>- A B1 level in French is the minimum required (participation to the French Summer School mandatory)</li> <li>- A B2 level in English is the minimum required to follow programs in English</li> </ul>
<b>Application form</b>	<p>The following documents must be included in the student's application and sent by email (address indicated above):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Application form duly completed (attached)</li> <li>- Official transcripts (in Portuguese, English or French)</li> <li>- CV and covering letter (in English or French)</li> <li>- Copy of passport</li> <li>- Proof of Language Proficiency (recommended)</li> </ul>
